

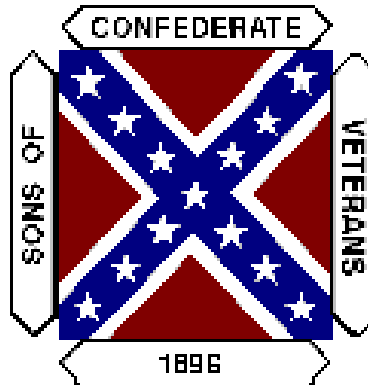

3/12/2011 Confederate Navy- Marine Corps Day: Annual ceremony to honor the Confederate States Naval and Marine Corps at Old St. Anne's Cemetery in Annapolis, Md. Color Guard members are asked to arrive by 10:30 A.M. for formation for the 11:00 ceremony. A very nice reception follows in St. Anne's hall. This is the 1st Naval Ceremony of the 150th Anniversary of the War Between the States.

4/16/2011 President's Street Station: This is officially a commemoration of the 150th Anniversary of the attack of Northern forces upon the south in Baltimore. Come one and all for the 1st historical commemoration event of the 150th

Anniversary of the War Between the States. This will be a major parade on Pratt St. to Camden Yards!
